Brazoria County will conduct a public meeting on the Chocolate Bayou Watershed Flood Planning Study. The study area encompasses the Chocolate Bayou Watershed, which includes portions of Brazoria and Fort Bend Counties; all or parts of the cities of Alvin, Iowa County, Liverpool, and Manvel; and portions of Brazoria County Drainage District #5, Brazoria County Conservation and Reclamation District #3, Danbury Drainage District #8, and Brazoria County Drainage District #4.

The meeting is being held to discuss the study currently underway, present information, and solicit public comment on drainage and flooding issues within the Chocolate Bayou watershed. The meeting will use an open-discussion format led by Brazoria County personnel, and held at the following:
