

BRAZORIA COUNTY BOARD OF PARK COMMISSION

STATEMENT OF PHILOSOPHY

Brazoria County should have a role in the development of Park and Recreation Resources which lies between that of the cities and of the State of Texas.

The national policy for parks and recreation adopted in 1964 by the National Association of Counties describes the special role of the county as “to acquire, develop, and maintain parks and administer public recreation programs that will serve the needs of communities broader than the local neighborhood but less than state or nationwide in scope”.

It shall be the policy of the Brazoria County Board of Park Commissioners to work closely with and under the leadership of Commissioners Court to investigate, plan, acquire, develop, and maintain a county-wide park system to meet the growing needs of the people of Brazoria County.
