## Precinct 2 Needs Assessment Meeting Results:

**March 6, 2008**

### **Lunch Meeting** (Jin Fu Buffet/Pearland) –

- Citizens have expressed the following opinions regarding the need in their area.
  - New Park should be located North of Hwy. 6, (possibly closer to Pearland so that it can tie into City of Pearland’s trail system), along a creek, or near Brazos Bend State Park
  - New park should be similar to Tom Bass Park
  - New Park to include: wildlife corridors (protection); bird/wildlife observation stations; natural habitat connected to City’s existing wildlife habitat; soccer fields; baseball/softball fields; pavilions; fishing availability; playgrounds; activities for high school kids (such as swimming, skating, bike riding, ATV usage)
  - Possible park themes: Off Road Vehicle, Skate
- Citizens have expressed the following opinions regarding existing parks in their region.
  - Resoft County Park – more usage of the islands is needed
- Priorities as expressed by citizens:
  - Land Acquisition
